

Baptist Health Breaks Ground On Third Combined ER and Urgent Care Facility

Innovative Facility on Bardstown Road Continues Expansion of Patient-First Healthcare Model

Louisville, Ky. (July 18, 2024) - <u>Baptist Health Kentucky</u>, in partnership with Dallas-based <u>Intuitive</u> <u>Health</u>, today broke ground on its third dual emergency and urgent care facility. Baptist Health ER & Urgent Care Glenmary is located at 7702 Bardstown Road, Louisville, KY 40291. This 11,400-square-foot facility is scheduled to open in the summer of 2025. This expansion follows the successful launch of its first facility, Baptist Health ER & Urgent Care Jeffersonville in Jeffersonville, IN, in 2022, followed by Baptist Health ER & Urgent Care Blankenbaker in Louisville, KY, in 2023.

This groundbreaking marks another significant step in Baptist Health's commitment to revolutionizing health care delivery in our region," said Jonathan Velez, M.D., president of Baptist Health Louisville. "Our third combined emergency and urgent care facility exemplifies our unwavering dedication to patient-centered innovation.
