



Baptist Health Care's First Intuitive Health-Partnered Dual ER and Urgent Care Facility Nearing Completion

New Clinic to Open in Navarre on September 28 at 7 a.m.

PENSACOLA, Fla. (August 11, 2020) – Plans for the opening of Baptist Emergency Room and Urgent Care in Navarre announced last September are on track. The facility will open in September at Baptist Medical Park – Navarre, located at 8888 Navarre Parkway.

A partnership between <u>Baptist</u> and <u>Intuitive Health</u> will bring the first hybrid emergency room and urgent care clinic to Northwest Florida. Texas-based Intuitive Health has partnered with established health systems nationwide since 2008 to build, operate, launch and retain health care facilities that provide urgent care and emergency room services under one roof. The dual emergency and urgent care facilities eliminate the need for patients to self-diagnose the severity of their health concern before selecting the most appropriate medical center for care. The new patient-centered model is designed to simplify the way patients access immediate, appropriate care while also lowering out-of-pocket costs.

"We've witnessed a growing issue across Northwest Florida and the entire country surrounding trying to guide consumers to the appropriate level of care," said Brett Aldridge, vice president of business development at Baptist Health Care. "Requiring patients to determine the level of care they require by choosing either a freestanding ER or urgent care is neither feasible nor safe. Through our partnership with Intuitive Health, Baptist Health Care is eliminating the guesswork and improving patient experience with a full-service emergency room and urgent care under one roof."

Baptist Emergency Room and Urgent Care, open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, will be equipped with on-site lab equipment, a radiology suite with X-ray and multi-slice CT scanners, and staffed with board-certified, ER-licensed physicians who will see each patient and determine if the appropriate care is emergent or urgent care. Patients are transparently billed accordingly, only paying for the level of care they need, which eliminates unnecessary emergency room visits.

"In addition to receiving the highest quality of care, patients want convenience, immediate access to care, better customer service and greater transparency in the billing process," said Thom Herrmann, CEO of Intuitive Health.
