Sidecar Social was designed by Brent Tipps to fulfill the need for DFW adults to have a place to hang out, relax and connect with friends with plenty of entertainment options including an eight-person foosball table, private Ping-Pong room, shuffleboard, bocce ball, pop-a-shot, corn hole and darts. Not into gaming? The sprawling complex also has a lounge with 18-foot TVs, private karaoke, live music and a massive tree-shaded patio that is dog-friendly. The weatherized Sidecar Social elevated patio is designed for humans and pets alike to enjoy a comfortable evening listening to live music or conversing over a plate of sharables from the scratch Sidecar Social kitchen.

In addition to creating a pet-friendly environment, Sidecar Social will also hold regular events to benefit Operation Kindness including special charity drives, fundraisers and adoptions hosted in partnership with the nonprofit shelter. Additionally, the entertainment restaurant is supporting their four-legged guests by creating a unique "pet menu" with proceeds from a doggie entree bowl going directly to Operation Kindness.

"Finding pet-friendly restaurants can be a challenge, and we're thrilled that Sidecar Social is incorporating them amongst their guests," Buxton said. "Providing a unique social lounge with a relaxing environment that both humans and dogs will enjoy will make for an awesome experience."
