"So we're giving the adoption fee discount our employees pay when they adopt. Our ultimate goal is to rescue more homeless dogs and cats and then have more happy pets going home with happy people."

COST: Dogs: Normal adoption fee is \$185, now only \$138.75
Cats: Normal adoption fee is \$135, now only \$101.25
The discount is only good at the 3201 Earhart campus location.

HOW: All available animals are listed on Operation Kindness' website, <http://www.OperationKindness.org>. Animals are rescued every day so the selection of pets is always changing.
