Owned by the City of College Station, home to Texas A&M University, the truck will be sure to get quite a few "whoops" when it drives through the town.

"We are delighted to unveil this special edition of the DC-64R refuse truck at such a special event," said Tim Thornton, vice president & general manager of Autocar's Refuse division. "College Station is one of the Lone Star State's fastest-growing cities, and this Autocar refuse truck will ensure that Texas A&M students and residents receive the essential services they expect and deserve in style. The Autocar DC-64R is the first truck ever built to feature ultra-high-strength 160,000 PSI steel frame rails, 24% stronger and lighter than the rails on other trucks on the market, eliminating the need for frame liners in nearly all refuse applications. The primary benefit for the waste hauler is a significant weight savings that directly increases effective payload – and therefore, profitability.

The DC-64R is the first new conventional truck in 33 years carrying the Autocar brand and joined the ACX and ACMD cabover trucks and the ACTT terminal tractor as Autocar's fourth line. The modern DC truck is a reminder of the long, proud history of the Autocar brand, which was also the nameplate on the original DC truck that was first introduced in 1939. That diesel-powered truck was revolutionary for the time.

The College Station DC-64R is available to view at FleetCon 2021 through September 1 and will be delivered to College Station later this week.
