



Northwest Health Combined Emergency Department and Urgent Care Opens in West Bentonville

BENTONVILLE (Jan. 10, 2022) — Northwest Health Emergency & Urgent Care, a department of Northwest Medical Center – Bentonville, is now open to residents and visitors of west Bentonville. Located at 1580 E. Centerton Blvd., it is the first of its kind in the area to combine emergency services and urgent care under one roof.

When deciding whether you need emergency or urgent care services, this combined model means you no longer need to choose where to go. This location is fully equipped to handle everything from allergies to appendicitis, with on-site labs, X-ray, ultrasound, and CT. And, patients will only be charged for the appropriate level of care.

As with any ER, emergency care will be provided 24/7. Urgent care services will be open Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-8 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday 8 p.m.-6 p.m. No appointment necessary, just walk-in.
